Rural Impact project partners researched and developed the content for Social Entrepreneurship Online Modules (WP2) with the aim of supporting young VET students in rural communities to develop skills to launch and maintain social enterprises. During this time, the partners also started creating the Up-skilling Programme for VET Professionals (WP3) with the aim of developing the digital skills **VET** professionals, including proficiency in the use of online tools, educational platforms and digital resources. These materials will be translated into 5 languages: EN, PT, HR, RO and BG.
